Roadrunner Debate Workshop, July 10-16...Cost-Commute \$400, W/Food & Lodging \$500
Instruction will focus on the 2010 high school resolution. Students will also gain knowledge over debate strategy, advanced research skills and communicative styles necessary to win debates in both the traditional or contemporary models. A separate set of lectures will be provided for those students who are alumni to our institute. The first week will conclude with a camp tournament.

Coyote Institute, July 10-22.....Cost-Commute \$500, W/Food & Lodging \$850
The second week will provide more hands on debate experience tailored to the needs of those students who choose to attend. The student to staff ratio is lower in this week giving students more one-on-one work time with instructors.

Coaches Workshop July 10-13.....Cost-Commute \$100, W/Food & Lodging \$275
Ken Troyer & Gary Harmon will lead this workshop for coaches of all levels of experience. Instruction will focus on the basics of running a competitive program with advanced coaching strategies for continued success. Coaches will also have the opportunity to attend lectures given by other instructors.

Coaches Institute July 10-16.....Cost-Commute \$125, W/Food & Lodging \$300
This institute will parallel our student institute. Coaches will have the opportunity to attend the same lectures that our students do, as well as attend the Coaches Workshop. In addition the coaches will set in on practice rounds, meet individually with our instructors, and have time to do individual research for their personal lectures for the upcoming school year.

Coaches & Students Debate Clinic August 27.....Cost \$15
Start the 2011-2012 Season with a clinic that will provide topic information, debate fundamentals, and a model debate for students and coaches. Coaches will attend as our guests. Lunch will be provided.
